



**2018 PETIT VERDOT**  
ESTATE GROWN – LODI, CALIFORNIA

**WINEMAKER NOTES**

Our 2018 Petit Verdot is deep purple in the glass and a symphony on the nose. Notes of blackberry, blueberry, mocha, and smoke lead the way to rich, dense, dark fruit on the palate. The wine finishes long & elegantly with smooth, rounded tannins.

**HARVEST & PRODUCTION NOTES**

Most of the fruit for our 2018 Petit Verdot comes from Lodi. The remainder came from sustainable vineyards within the Valley.

The fruit for our 2018 Petit Verdot was harvested between September 10th and October 16th with an average Brix of 26.0. After 7-9 days of fermentation on the skins, the resulting wine was pressed and finished fermentation in stainless steel tanks. The wine was then aged on new and used French and American Oak for 4-6 months.

**BLEND**

Our blend is predominantly Petit Verdot with some Tannat and Petite Sirah.
